

Mexico City signs Memorandum of Understanding on Healthcare with Bogotá

On Friday, April 22nd, Mexico City Mayor, Miguel Ángel Mancera, visited Bogotá, Colombia, in order to sign a Memorandum of Understanding, focused on healthcare issues, with Enrique Peñalosa Londoño, Mayor of Bogotá.

The Memorandum of Understanding contemplates different modalities for the exchange of knowledge and experiences, particularly, regarding the programs “El Médico en tu Casa” and the “Comprehensive Healthcare Model”,



so that they can be replicated in the Colombian capital.

Through this cooperation instrument, the basis for the implementation of joint actions to improve the knowledge of officials working in the healthcare sector, from both cities, was established; and the ties of friendship and cooperation with the Colombian capital, strengthened.

Also, in a meeting between the Mayors of Mexico City and Bogotá, a wide range of challenges facing cities were discussed, particularly in mobility, urban development, environment, security and technology.

Mexico City Delegation makes an official visit to Los Angeles, California

On Thursday, April 7th, a delegation from the Mexico City Government, headed by Cuauhtémoc Cárdenas Solórzano, Coordinator General of International Affairs; and the Minister of Economic Development, Salomón Chertorivski Woldenberg, visited the City of Los Angeles, in order to strengthen the ties of friendship and cooperation with this sister city of our capital city since 1969.

As part of the visit, the Mexico City Government donated to Los Angeles, a replica of the “Wings of Mexico”, a sculpture created by Mexican



artist Jorge Marin, which is currently in exhibition in 5 cities around the world: Shanghai, Tel Aviv, Berlin, Singapore and Mexico City.

Our capital’s delegation also met with the Mayor of Los Angeles, Eric Garcetti, with whom they discussed possible cooperation schemes between both cities, in the field of clean energy, sustainability and infrastructure.

Moreover, the Minister of Economic Development met with members of the Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce, in order to promote Mexico City as an attractive destination for investment.
