On Monday 1 of August, Miguel Ángel Mancera, Mayor of Mexico City, received Mr. Peter Cosgrove, Governor General of the Commonwealth of Australia, in the City Hall.

Mr. Cosgrove was recognized as Distinguished Guest of Mexico.

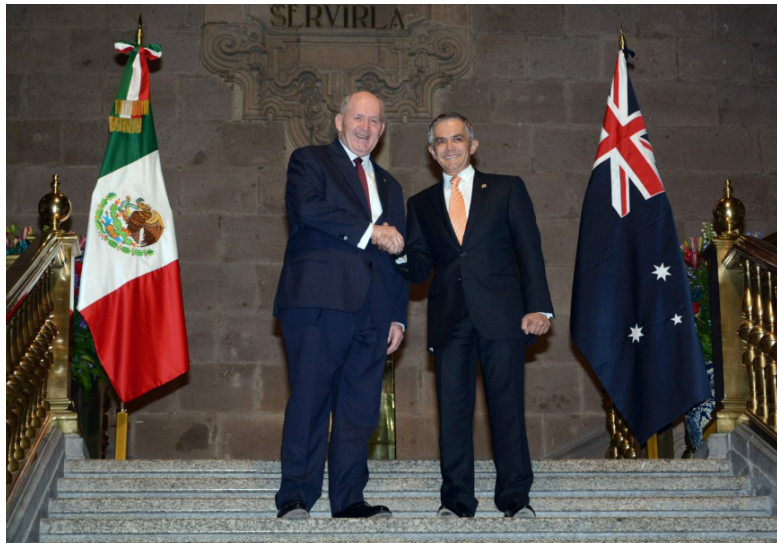
The ceremony was attended by Mr. David Engel, Australian Ambassador to Mexico; Cuauhtémoc Cárdenas Solorzano, Coordinator General of International Affairs; Salomón Chertorivski Woldenberg, Minister of Economic Development; Felipe de Jesús Gutiérrez Gutiérrez, Minister of Urban Development and other

members of the Legal and Extended Cabinet.

At the meeting was noted that this is the first Official Visit of an Australia's

Head of State in Mexico City. Mayor Mancera recognized the agenda that the Australian cities of Melbourne and Sydney, promoted in several international

networks such as the Climate Leadership Group (C40), which Sixth Mayors Summit will take place in Mexico City. Governor Cosgrove emphasized the cultural wealth and tourism potential of the capital -recognized by The New York Times as the 2016 number one tourist destination- mentioning that annually 80,000 Australians visit the city and other tourist sites in Mexico.



● MAYOR MANCERA NAMES PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF PARAGUAY DISTINGUISHED GUEST

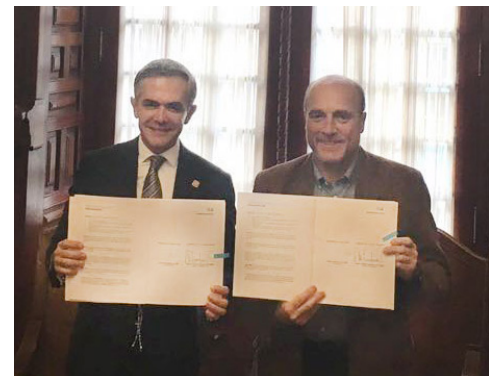
On Friday, August 26, Mayor of Mexico City, Miguel Ángel Mancera, met with Mr. Horacio Cartes Jara, President of the Republic of Paraguay, in the City Hall. Mr. Cartes was recognized as Distinguished Guest of Mexico City and was given the Key of the City.

Mayor Mancera highlighted the main lines of action raised in the Paraguayan National Development Plan, with short and medium term objectives and indicators; shared successful experiences and best practices of Mexico City in areas such as inclusive and sustainable mobility, and social development. The participation of the Diplomatic Representation of Paraguay in the Friendly Cultures Fair was also emphasized. Meanwhile, the President of Paraguay countersigned fraternity as a basis of the relations between the South American nation and Mexico City.

Mexico City signs Memorandum of Understanding with the Municipality of Montevideo

On Tuesday, August 30, Mayor of Mexico City, Miguel Ángel Mancera received the official visit of Mr. Daniel Martínez Villamil, Mayor of Montevideo, Uruguay, in the City Hall, in order to subscribe a Memorandum of Understanding on Culture, Human Rights, Innovation, Governance and ICT (Information and Communication Technologies), International Networks and Strategy.

Through this instrument that proposes and regulates, within the framework of international cooperation, strategies for exchange



of mutual benefit, we aim to strengthen our bilateral cooperation and friendly relations, as well as promote joint efforts in the above mentioned fields.

● VICE MAYOR OF NAGOYA, JAPAN'S OFFICIAL VISIT TO MEXICO CITY

On Monday 8 and Tuesday 9 of August, a delegation from the city of Nagoya, Japan, headed by the Vice Mayor, Mr. Teruo Shinkai, made an Official Visit to Mexico City. During their mission, they held meetings with representatives of the International Affairs Office, the Ministries of Culture and Tourism, and the Water System of the Mexico City Government.

The visit aimed to follow up on collaborative projects implemented by Mexico City and Nagoya, as a result of the Twinning Agreement signed by both cities in 1977; as well as planning the celebration of the 40th anniversary of their relations, which will be commemorated in 2017.
