

# Mayor of Mexico City makes an official visit to Chicago, USA



On December 5, the Mayor of Mexico City, Miguel Ángel Mancera, made an official visit to the city of Chicago, Illinois, United States, accompanied by the Minister for Environment, Tanya Müller García; the Minister of Economic Development, Salomón Chertorivski Woldenberg; and the Coordinator General of the Cabinet, Julio César Serna Chávez.

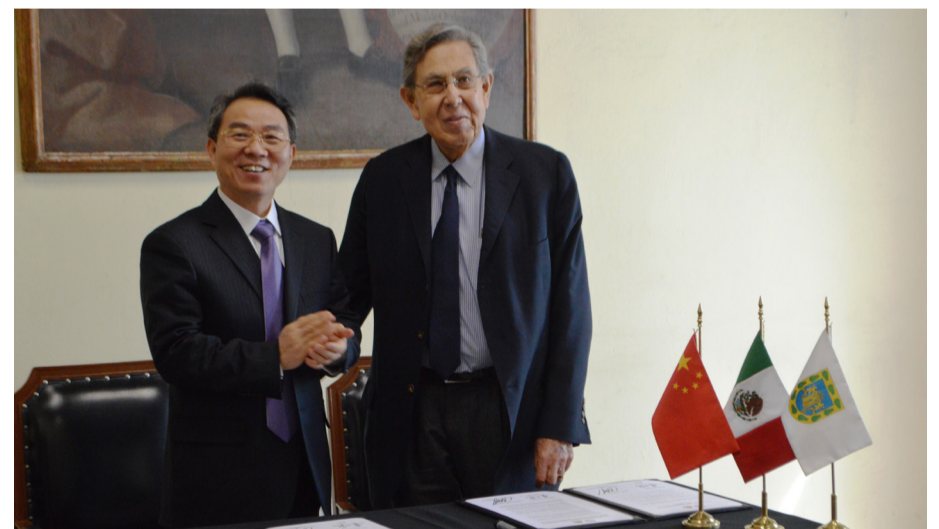
As part of its work agenda, the Mayor attended the North American Climate Summit, an event in which, along with 40 cities, signed the 'Declaration of Chicago', an agreement that establishes specific commitments and joint actions against to climate change, and that emerged as an initiative of the Mayor of Chicago, Rahm Emanuel, in partnership with the C40 network and the Global Covenant of Mayors for Climate and Energy.

During the Summit, in addition, the fifth annual edition of C40 Cities Bloomberg Philanthropies Awards was held, a ceremony in which Mexico City was awarded in the 'Cities4Action' category, in recognition of the progress of the Mexico City's Climate Action Program 2014-2020.

## Mexico City signs cooperation agreement with Shanghai, China

On December 4, Cuauhtémoc Cárdenas Solórzano, Coordinator General of International Affairs, received in Mexico City the official visit of a delegation from the Municipality of Shanghai, China, headed by Dong Yunhu, a permanent member of the Communist Party of China's Municipal Committee of Shanghai, Minister of Publicity, and Representative of the Mayor.

Within this framework, they signed a cooperation agreement, with the aim of formalizing and deepening both the ties of friendship and bilateral cooperation in several issues of common interest, mainly culture and design. Furthermore, the Municipality of Shanghai delivered the 'Shanghai Window' plate, a project through which publications on Chinese culture will be donated to Mexico City.
