

Mexico City hosts the C40's 2nd Women4Climate Summit

On February 26th, in the Interactive Economy Museum (MIDE), the Mayor of Mexico City, Miguel Ángel Mancera, inaugurated the C40's 2nd Women4Climate Summit, in which participated representatives from 92 cities of different countries.

"With the leadership of committed women on the fight against Climate Change some public policy lines are generated for governments all over the world", highlighted Mayor Mancera during his intervention.

The Women4Climate initiative emerged from the C40's Sixth Biannual Summit of Mayors, which took place in Mexico City on 2016, in closed collaboration with the Mayor of Paris and C40 President, Anne Hidalgo.



Since then, its main objectives are:

- To empower and to inspire the next generation of climate leaders, through a global program of tutorial dedicated to women in the C40 cities
- To encourage climate action, presenting an annual challenge dedicated to innovative women on climate and sustainability
- To influence on the global climate conversation, through leadership events and to create a new vocation among future leaders.

Besides, within the framework of this Summit, the Mayor of Mexico City held a bilateral meeting with

the Mayor of Montreal, Valerie Planter, to dialogue about sustainable development.
