

Mexico City Mayor participates in the C40 Latin American Mayors Forum, in Buenos Aires, Argentina

From March 26 to 28, Mexico City Mayor, Mr. Miguel Ángel Mancera Espinosa, made an official visit to the city of Buenos Aires, Argentina, in order to participate in the first C40 Latin American Mayors Forum, where he shared our capital's best practices on sustainability, as panelist in a plenary session entitled "Promoting Latin American commitments on Climate Change".

Also, on behalf of the Mexico City Government, Mr. Mancera signed the "Compact of Mayors", which is the world's largest cooperative effort among mayors and city officials to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, track



progress, and prepare for the impacts of climate change. He also signed the City Clean Bus Declaration of Intent, a commitment by C40 cities to reducing emissions and improving air quality through the introduction of low- and zero-emission buses in their fleets.

Moreover, within the framework of this official visit, he met with Cristina Fernandez de Kirchner, President of Argentina; Daniel Scioli,

Governor of the Buenos Aires Province; Eduardo Paes, Mayor of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil; and Mauricio Rodas, Mayor of Quito, Ecuador.

Mexico City Mayor makes an official visit to São Paulo, Brazil

On March 29 and 30, as part of his Official Visit to the city of São Paulo, Brazil; Mexico City Mayor, Mr. Miguel Ángel Mancera Espinosa, exchanged experiences with Mayor Fernando Haddad, on waste management issues during technical visits to the Mechanized Plant of Dry Waste Selection, which separates six thousand tons of waste daily, and the Mobile Unit "Rede Hora Certa".

Moreover, Mexico City was recognized for its health policies on obesity treatment, by the Brazilian Society for Bariatric Surgery. It was in this context that Mexico City's Ministry of Health signed a Memorandum of Understanding regarding obesity treatment projects with the Bariatric Surgery Clinic of the Hospital de Clinicas of São Paulo.

Finally, Mr. Mancera met with Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva, former president of Brazil.
